STORMWATER MANAGEMENT & SOIL EROSION CONTROL ORDINANCE
PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE**

Effective April 1, 2017

At the time of application for a stormwater management and soil erosion control permit, a non-refundable permit fee according to the following schedule shall be charged. The total permit fee shall be the sum of the soil erosion and sedimentation control plan and, if applicable, stormwater management plan and outside plan review and inspection fees.

A. Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plan Review and Inspection Fees:

Corridor Developments:

- a. Up to 1.0 mile\$100.00
- b. 1.0 or more miles\$75.00 per mile or fraction thereof

Area Developments:

- a. New Home\$100.00
- b. Garage or Addition\$50.00

Soil erosion and sedimentation control plan fees are to be computed utilizing the size of the earth disturbance.

B. Stormwater Management Plan Review and Inspection Fees:

Subdivisions, Condominiums, Mobile Home Parks & Other Residential Developments:

- a. Base fee.....\$100.00

Commercial, Industrial & Other Non-Residential Developments:

- a. Base fee.....\$100.00
- b. Plus additional\$75.00 per acre or fraction thereof

C. Outside Plan Review and Inspection Fees - If the Drain Commissioner determines that a soil erosion and sedimentation control plan and/or a stormwater management plan needs to be reviewed and/or inspected for compliance by an outside consultant, up to 75% of the respective fees may be applied towards such work. Prior to the issuance of a permit, the Drain Commissioner shall prepare a reasonable estimate of cost for any such work. If the estimated cost is in excess of 75% of the respective fees, the applicant shall deposit with the Drain Commissioner an amount sufficient to cover the cost of such work. After the issuance of a permit, should the deposit not be sufficient to cover the cost of such work, the permittee shall increase the amount of the deposit to cover such expenses. The failure to keep an adequate amount on deposit shall be considered sufficient grounds for the permit to be suspended in accordance with Section 3.06 of the Ordinance. Any excess outside plan review and inspection fees shall be refunded to the permittee.

D. Appeal Fee: \$200.00 per application

E. Violations - All permit fees shall be doubled, subject to a \$100.00 minimum, if site work has been started prior to the issuance of a permit.

F. Fee Exemptions - Units of government or agencies thereof are exempt from the payment of permit fees.
