The regular meeting of the Mason County Board of Commissioners was held at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room located in the Mason County Courthouse in the City of Ludington.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lange.

Roll call was taken. Present: W. Taranko, B. Carpenter, C. Lange, C. VanderWall,

S. Hull, J. Andersen, T. Posma

Absent: None.

Invocation was given by C. VanderWall. Pledge to the flag followed.

Motion by C. VanderWall and seconded by B. Carpenter to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion by J. Andersen and seconded by W. Taranko to approve the minutes of the February 10, 2015 regular meeting. Motion carried.

No correspondence was read.

Public Comment:

- Western Michigan Fair Association Board President Kirk Meyers stated he was in attendance to answer any questions regarding the proposed project at the fairgrounds that was the reason to submit a Natural Resources Trust Fund Grant Application to the Michigan Department of Natural Resources.
- Riverton Township resident Evelyn Bergaila spoke in support of the proposal for the post mitigation sound survey for the Lake Winds Energy Park.

Mason County Sheriff Kim Cole reviewed the events that had occurred within the county in 2014 that had major impacts on the Mason County Sheriff's Department. The Sheriff stated that as of August 14 all the patrol cars have in-car cameras and the department continues to work especially hard on increasing traffic safety on the US-10 corridor.

District Health Department #10 Health Officer Linda VanGills gave her annual report (her last as she will be retiring in June after 35 years of service) and spoke about the goals and strategic plan as well as the quality improvement projects for 2014. District #10 Health Department anticipates being the 3rd health department in Michigan to receive National Accreditation in the near future. The department currently employees 180 employees.

Drain Commissioner David Hasenbank gave his 2014 report (his last report as he will be retiring on March 31st) and reviewed the activities within county drainage districts as well as Inland Lake Boards and the Department of Public Works.

Motion by T. Posma and seconded by C. VanderWall to close the regular session and go into a public hearing on the submission of a Natural Resources Trust Fund Grant Application to the Michigan Department of Natural Resources. Motion carried. Chairman Lange asked Western Michigan Fair Association Board President Kirk Meyers to explain the proposed project to expand the campground at the Western Michigan Fairgrounds in order to further provide recreational facilities at the site. Mr. Meyers gave a brief history of the project and the need to scale down the initial project due to the costs of a proposed bathroom/shower facility. The proposed project includes 26 new full service campsites and a new dump station. During the discussion it was pointed out that the grant requested amount would be \$266,500 with the county committing \$95,000 toward the park improvements if the grant is awarded. Mr. Meyers stated the Western Michigan Fair Association Board has already begun discussions and will plan to raise the \$95,000 through fund-raising efforts and proceeds from planned activities. Chairman Lange expressed that he felt past experience for these types of projects had been very positive. With no other discussion or comments from the public a motion was made by T. Posma and seconded by W. Taranko to close the public hearing and go back to regular session. Motion carried.
