The possibility of utilizing the Scottville Building for a broadband office was also discussed should the Board move forward with that initiative.

After significant discussion, it was recommend to refer back to the Building, Planning, Airport, and Drain committee to discuss with the Scottville Office staff, look at space at the Courthouse, invite the Treasurer's Office, Clerk's Office, Deputy Equalization Director, Zoning Office, Drain Office to the next meeting and discuss options.
