45 46 47	Brian Zatloukal and Eric Gustad were present to answer questions from the Planning Commission members.

Mike Shaw stated there were concerns regarding whether the decommissioning bond 1 2 would cover today's labor costs. 3 Brian Zatloukal stated the US Department of Labor Statistics inflation calendar was used 4 as it was in 2017. Mr. Zatloukal stated he was confident in how the number was reached. 5 6 Alan Neushwander asked if there were any updates on the complaints of flicker and 7 8 grease leakage. 9 10 Brian Zatloukal stated no complaints had been received from residences within the park boundaries. Mr. Zatloukal stated the equipment was operational and checked on a regular 11 basis to make sure commitments are being met. Mr. Zatloukal added that the grease 12 issue was a result of a different formula used, and the decision to go back to the original 13 formula had been made. 14 15 Eric Gustad stated there is a formal complaint process which ensures a paper trail to 16 document issues are being addressed and resolved. 17 18 Mike Shaw stated Consumers Energy was doing a great job with the problem resolution 19 20 process. 21 Jim Wincek stated the Planning Commission was appreciative that the issue with the 22 grease was resolved so quickly. 23 24 Jim Wincek suggested postponing decisions on the solar ordinance language since some 25 members of the Planning Commission were not present at the meeting; however, he 26 opened the floor for discussion. 27 28 The Planning Commission agreed to wait until the next meeting. 29 30 Zoning Directors Report: Cayla Christmas stated there were no agenda items for 31 February 2<sup>nd</sup>. 32 33 Zoning Board of Appeals: None 34 35 Jim Wincek stated the Planning Commission would need to select a new member to 36 represent the commission on the Zoning Board of Appeals. 37 38 Jim Wincek opened public comment. 39 40 Meeting adjourned at 7:47 P.M. 41
