Public Safety & Courts Committee Meeting
February 22, 2022

Commissioner Castonia called the Public Safety & Courts Committee Meeting to order at 12:30 p.m. in the conference room of the Mason County Airport. Members present: C. Castonia, L. Squires and J. Hartley. Absent: None. Also present Animal Control Officer S. Colbrook, Emergency Manager L. Reimink, Undersheriff Wilson, Treasurer Kmetz, Judge Nellis, Administrator F. Knizacky, and Clerk C. Kelly.

Motion by L. Squires and seconded by J. Hartley to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion by J. Hartley and seconded by G. Castonia to approve the minutes from the January 25, 2022 meeting. Motion carried.

Reading of Correspondence: None.

Limited Public Comment: None.

Consideration of operational policies for Courthouse Security: Judge Nellis presented to review the Local Administrative Order (LAO) he had written for a single point of entry for the Courthouse. After-hours access would be granted to department heads and elected officials only. Other staff needing access after-hours access would need to provide written documentation from the department head/elected official as to why they need to come in after hours. The new LAO would make the east-side entrance the main entry for all who are entering the building. It was discussed to allow employees to exit out the west side lower level door, as well as have law enforcement bring prisoners through that entrance. Law enforcement officials entering the building in uniform would be allowed to carry, but off duty law enforcement would not be given the same privileges. Motion by J. Hartley and seconded by L. Squires to send to the full board for consideration the operational policies with the changes noted for courthouse security. Motion carried.

Consideration of a presentation by Wayne Kuipers from Impact Strategic Solutions, LLC (Commissioner Squires): Wayne Kuipers provided a presentation regarding ultraviolet light sterilization for COVID-19 and other viruses. A three-unit light system is \$10,000.00, which would include a stand. No residue would be left if using this type of cleaning system. Demonstration only, no decision was made.

Consideration of a request to purchase a computer form the Equipment Replacement Fund (Animal Control Officer Colbrook): Animal Control Officer Colbrook reviewed her request to purchase an additional laptop to be utilized in the vehicle while on the road to access the Dog Licensing program. Funding of \$989.00 to come from the Equipment Replacement Fund. It was noted that the Animal Control Officers will utilize the hotspots on their personal cell phones to have internet access. Motion by L. Squires and seconded by J. Hartley to recommend to the Finance, Personnel, and Rules Committee the purchase of the laptop for \$989.00 from the Equipment Replacement Fund. Motion carried.

Consideration of a request to dispose of Homeland Security purchased equipment (Emergency Management Coordinator Reimink): Emergency Manager Reimink requested to dispose of audio-visual equipment that was purchased with the FY2007 Homeland Security Grant Program. Rules indicate that the Board of Commissioners must authorize the disposal of this equipment. Motion by J. Hartley and seconded by L. Squires to send the request to dispose of Homeland Security purchased equipment to the full board with the recommendation to approve. Motion carried.

Consideration of a request to purchase vests from the Equipment Replacement Fund (Sheriff Cole): Undersheriff Wilson presents to review the request to purchase 17 vests from the Equipment Replacement Fund. Seven vests for road patrol at a cost of \$597 each and ten vests for corrections at a cost of \$837, 00 each, total cost \$12,564.00. The difference in cost for the corrections vests is that these vests are ballistic proof and stab proof. It was noted that 50% of the cost would be reimbursed from a BPV Grant. Motion by G. Castonia and seconded by J. Hartley to send the request to purchase vests from the Equipment Replacement Fund to the Finance, Personnel & Rules Committee with the recommendation to approve. Motion carried.

Consideration of the need for scanning equipment for the security at the Mason County Courthouse: Administrator Knizacky provided documentation regarding a walk-through metal detector (approximate cost \$3,600-\$4,395), a hand wand (approximate cost \$138-\$195), and an x-ray unit (approximate cost \$16,000 to \$20,000). It was noted that he will check with Michigan Municipal Risk Management Association to see if there is any risk avoidance funding available to assist with costs. It was discussed to utilize all pieces of equipment presented for the April 1, 2022 start date of the new security at the Courthouse. Motion by L. Squires and seconded by J. Hartley to recommend to the Finance, Personnel, & Rules Committee to purchase all of the above equipment. Motion carried.

Limited Public Comments: Judge Nellis thanked the Committee and Administrator Knizacky for the time spent with regards to the courthouse security project.

Any Other Business: None.

Motion by J. Hartley and seconded by C. Castonia to adjourn the meeting at 1:20 p.m.

CONTRACT PROPOSAL FOR JUVENILE TREATMENT PLACEMENTS

MONROE COUNTY YOUTH CENTER 2 beds, \$175.00 per day each bed 30 day out clause Terminates December 31, 2022

There is an incredible shortage of juvenile treatment/detention beds in the state of Michigan at this time. It is more difficult to place a child in treatment/detention than any other time in my 22 year career in the juvenile court. There are multiple reasons for the shortage. COVID-19 has made it almost impossible to move kids from one county to another; very few, if any, county-run detention centers are taking out of county kids at this time. They list COVID restrictions or low staff numbers as the reason they are not taking kids. Although we have great relationships with several detention centers, they have all informed us over the last two years they are no longer able to take our kids.

Ottawa County Detention Center	No longer accepting out of county kids
Midland County Detention Center	Mason County must be under 10% positivity rate (COVID)
Bay County Detention Center	No longer accepting out of county kids due to low staffing numbers
Sault Tribe Youth Center	No longer accepting out of county kids due to low staffing numbers
Roscommon County Detention Center	No longer accepting out of county kids due to low staffing numbers
Allen County (Indiana) Detention Center	Currently full and not accepting kids

Residential Treatment Centers

Lakeside Residential	Shut down by the State of Michigan – inappropriate treatment resulting in death
Wolverine Residential	State of Michigan reduced overall bed capacity by 500 beds
Starr Commonwealth	State of Michigan reduced overall bed capacity by 150 beds
Eagle Village	No longer accepts DL cases
Shawono Residential	12-18 month waiting list to get a child into care
Bay Pines Center	18 24 month waiting list to get child into care
Canyon State Academy	Located in Mesa, Arizona. Due to location this is not always feasible

We currently have seven children placed, as described. We have three additional children that will need placement as soon as the court process concludes. This is an unusually high number of placements for Mason County. Only through the creative and persistent work of the juvenile court staff have the current placements been possible. We'll continue to work to reduce the number of kids in placement with the understanding that community/personal safety is our number one priority.

Child #2	Shawono (CSC against a child under 13)
Child #3	Allen County Detention Center (Armed Robbery / Strangulation)

Child #6	Monroe County Detention Center (Drugs / Runaway / Domestic Violence)
Child #7	Great Lakes Recovery Center (Drugs / Alcohol / Attended middle school with a .135 BAC)

I am requesting that the Board of Commissioners approve this contract with the Monroe County Youth Center and provide necessary treatment options for Mason County Juvenile Court to keep the children and citizens of Mason County safe.

**MONROE COUNTY YOUTH CENTER
AND
MASON COUNTY JUVENILE COURT**

THIS AGREEMENT, is made this 10th day of February 2022, between the Monroe COUNTY YOUTH CENTER, 3600 S. Custer Road, Monroe, MI 48161, hereinafter referred to as the "YOUTH CENTER", the COUNTY of Monroe, 125 E. Second Street, Monroe, MI 48161, hereinafter referred to as the "COUNTY" and MASON COUNTY JUVENILE COURT, 304 E. Ludington Ave., Ludington, MI 49431 hereinafter referred to as "MASON COUNTY" (each a "PARTY" collectively the "PARTIES").

WHEREAS, Mason County is in need of a secure, treatment program housing for adjudicated youth from their county;

WHEREAS, Youth Center will provide two (2) Treatment program beds exclusive for two (2) individual youths from Mason County;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants hereinafter set forth, the *Parties* hereto agree as follows:

Article I - Authorization

The *Youth Center* will accept referrals from *Mason County* to the Monroe County Youth Center Treatment Program for youth that are adjudicated for non-status offenses. Each youth must be between the ages of 11 – 17, and not have a significant history of violence or severe mental health issues.

The *Youth Center* reserves the right to request a removal of any youth placed in the Treatment Program due to extreme behavior issues. The request must be in written form to *Mason County* and, upon receipt of written request, *Mason County* will remove the youth from the *Youth Center* within 72 hours. The written request for removal shall be submitted via email communication or facsimile.

Article II - Cost of Services

The *Youth Center* agrees to bill *Mason County* a per diem of \$175.00 per bed/ per day. In addition, *Mason County* is financially responsible to pay for billed services for Certified Substance Abuse Counseling at the rate of, \$120 / session, billed services from Monroe County Community Mental Health for services agreed upon, and any cost of medication/healthcare services, or educational exams.

Youth Center will provide a detailed monthly invoice to *Mason County*. Invoices that are not provided within six (6) months of services rendered will not be paid by *Mason County*.

Mason County will pay all invoices within 45 days of the date of the invoice. Payment shall be remitted to "County of Monroe"; make check payable to Monroe County Treasurer's Office, 51 S. Macomb St., Monroe, MI 48161 and reference the service for which payment is made.

Article III – Scope of services

The responsibilities of the *Youth Center* shall include the following:

1. Maintain licensing requirements to operate as a Juvenile Court Operated Residential Care Facility.
2. Provide individual and family therapy to each youth and their family placed at the Youth Center.
3. Provide Mason County probation officers with monthly updated service plans on each youth to communicate progress or barriers in individual Treatment goals.

Article IV - Indemnification

Mason County agrees to assume all risk, medical costs or incidental costs that may arise from an injury or related issue while youth is in the care of the Monroe County Youth Center. The undersigned releases and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the County of Monroe, the Monroe County Youth Center, the 38th Judicial Circuit Court Family Division and all of their employees and agents as well as other participating agencies from and against any loss, damage, injury or liability of any nature including but not limited to attorney fees which may directly or indirectly result from or arise as a result of being detained at the Monroe County Youth Center.

Article VI - Terms of the agreement

This professional services agreement shall commence as first written above, and shall continue until December 31, 2022.

This agreement may be modified through an addendum executed by all parties.

Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, either party may terminate this agreement at any time for any reason whatsoever without further obligation to the other upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other.

Article VII - Waiver

The waiver by either party of a breach of any provision of this agreement shall not operate as, or be construed as, a waiver of any subsequent breach.

Article X - Modification

No change, modification or waiver of any term of this agreement shall be valid unless it is in writing and signed by both *parties*.

**Life EMS Ambulance of Mason County
Ambulance Report
Oct 1 through December 31, 2021**

Ambulance operations for Life EMS of Mason County ran well during the fourth quarter of 2021, with staffing being our most challenging obstacle.

During this reporting period, Life EMS completed 950 ambulance transports and on scene assessments in Mason County. This is 85 more than during the same time period last year. The Mason County operation had a total of 3,973 transports and on scene assessments for 2021. This reflects a 13% increase over last year.

We are continuing to look at improvements for our work environment to assist in retention and attract new associates to the Mason County operation. One of the positive changes for our associates was to delay non-emergent inter-facility transfers after 22:00, allowing more appropriate rest on our 24-hour shifts. We've been fortunate to have support from several other operations, along with leadership, filling many of the open shifts. We have 2 paramedics from our Grand Rapids operation that are currently assigned to regular shifts in Mason County, providing much needed assistance.

We've been fortunate to have very few of our staff test positive for Covid-19. Beginning last spring we gained the ability to rapid test associates through supplies initially received through District Health Department #10, and now directly from the state.

We participated in a few community events during the fourth quarter, including:

Shop with a Hero

West Shore ESD tour for students

Ludington New Year's Eve planning and coverage

We also remain active in the following local groups and committees: LPT, LEPC, School Safety, 911 board, Child Death Review, both local and regional Medical Control Authorities which include Professional Standards Review Organization, WMRMCC protocol committee, West Shore Community College EMS Advisory Board.

Our on-duty associates were provided Thanksgiving and Christmas Dinners from Honey Baked Hams on behalf of Life EMS to show our appreciation for their dedication in keeping Mason County well-staffed during the holidays.

There were 3 requests for fire standbys during this reporting period resulting in over 2.5 hours assigned coverage for the health and safety of area firefighters.

Thank you for allowing Life EMS to provide excellent service to the residents and visitors of Mason County.
